Titan is a medium-maturing timothy that is easily established. It responds extremely well to moisture and performs well in soils with good drainage. It has great winter hardiness and shows excellent spring green-up. It is extremely persistent and reliable in all grass-legume mixtures.

USES

FORAGE:

Titan timothy is well-suited to planting alone or with other species. With wide dark green leaves, Titan produces an abundance of forage. It shows exceptional regrowth, providing an extended production window. Titan is desirable grass for horses due to lower sugar levels and soft leaves.

HAY:

Titan timothy makes excellent hay for livestock and silage for dairy. It works well as a monoculture or in a mixture with alfalfa, red clover, or birdsfoot trefoil.

EROSION CONTROL:

Titan Timothy can be used with legumes and/or other grasses for cover purposes, filter strips, along waterways, or in other critical area applications.
